

Misconduct by any participant in the Advanced Program, including players, coaches, parents or affiliated spectators is not tolerated. If misconduct is identified, the matter will be brought to the Competitive Committee and the Director of Coaching for evaluation, discussion and disposition. The individual identified with misconduct may choose to appear before the Competitive Committee and Director of Coaching. Disciplinary action is decided by the Competitive Committee and the Director of Coaching, requiring a majority vote of members present. Disciplinary action may include, but is not limited to, suspension or expulsion for the duration of a single game up to lifetime for player and or parent. Disciplinary action will be reported to the Executive Committee of Cheyenne Soccer Club.
